

Sheep General Rules & Regulations

1. All exhibitors must be a paid-up member of the SWOLPA (\$5.00 will be deducted from sale of sheep)
2. Entries must be a bona fide property of exhibitor from time of entry prior to the show and cannot have been consigned to any previous market sales
3. 6% sales commission plus GST will be deducted to defray expenses.
4. All sheep must be classified on Tuesday, October 13, 2026 between 9:00am and 11:00am DST at the fairgrounds. This will be the weight for which the sale weight is calculated.
5. Animals will be classified in classes according to weights, with a maximum of 9 animals per class.
6. All animals must be shown in designated classes and must be sold.
7. The executive has the power to excuse any animal that is not complimentary to the show.
8. All sheep at owner's risk until sold, then at purchaser's risk.
9. Payment to be made at par to the Secretary/Treasurer the night of the show.
10. Money can be withheld or deducted from sales proceeds for any cause which the management feels justified.
11. The decision of the judge will be final and no protest or appeal will be entertained except where actual fraud exists.
12. Entries open to the province of Ontario.
13. The management reserves the right to make additional rules for the better carrying out of the show.
14. It shall be condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold the SWOLPA and its directors blameless for any loss or damage, however caused. The association will not be responsible or liable for any injury sustained by exhibitors, spectators or employees.
15. All sheep are to be sold with a halter.
16. Maximum sale weight will be 135 pounds for sheep.
17. That all animals be weight exempt for the Red Brand Show.
18. There will be no buy bidding allowed at the Red Brand Show & Sale.
19. Arrangements to be made with the Secretary the night of the show for shipment of the animal or the animal will be shipped to the destination of the committees' choice.
20. All entries must be tagged with CSIP approved ear tag.
21. Animals will only be sold once. Unless new owner decides to resell the animal.
22. SWOLP will invoice per sale of animal.
23. All sheep exhibitors are limited to only one entry per exhibitor.
24. All exhibitors must pre-register online by Friday September 11th, 2026.
25. All animals must remain in the designated area from weigh in and until after the sale.
26. If an entry is residue tested and is positive, the purchaser and agent shall be refunded fully by the exhibitor. As well, the exhibitor shall be banned for further SWOLPA shows.
27. No unnatural means of providing an animal feed, water or other fluid (i.e. stomach pump) will be allowed. Exhibitors will be disqualified

Rules and Regulation

Rules governing Section A:

1. All animals shown must be sold.
2. The two top animals in each class are eligible to show in the championship classes.
3. The juniors are limited to one exhibit in the Showmanship Class at the Red Brand Show.

Section A – Market Lambs

Section B - Showmanship Classes

Prize money will be awarded.

Classes

1. PeeWee Showperson—5 to 8 as of January 1, 2026
2. Junior Showperson—9 to 14 as of January 1, 2026
3. Senior Showperson—15 to 21 as of January 1, 2026

NOTE: Contestants must register for this class at the morning weigh in.

Section D - Ivomec Challenge This is sponsored by Merial, makers of *Ivomec Pour-on and Injection for Cattle*. Participating showmanship members will be part of a quiz show type event. There will be questions relating to cattle, sheep, and agriculture for different age groups. The event will take place in the Ag Hall from 11:30am to 12:00pm

Section E- Final Drive

The winners of first and second place in Section A classes are to compete for Over All Champion Market Lamb and Reserve Champion Market Lamb.

1. Section B: Showmanship
2. Section A: Market Lamb
3. Grand Champion Market Lamb
4. Pair of Lambs from one family

1. Grand Champion Market Lamb
2. Reserve Grand Champion Market Lamb
3. The Balance of the Animals left in the Grand Champion Market Lamb final drive as Put in Order by the Judge
4. Balance of Section A
